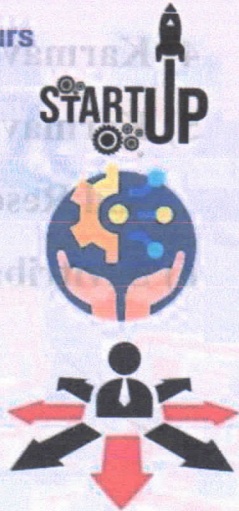

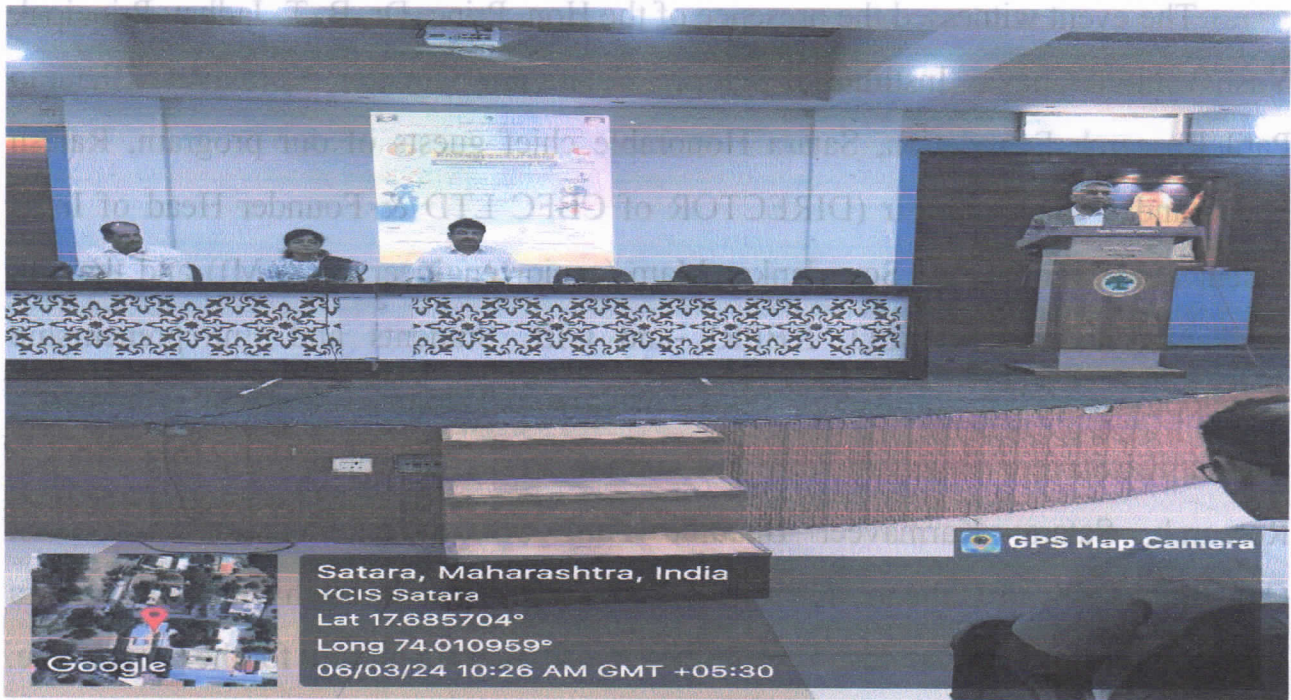

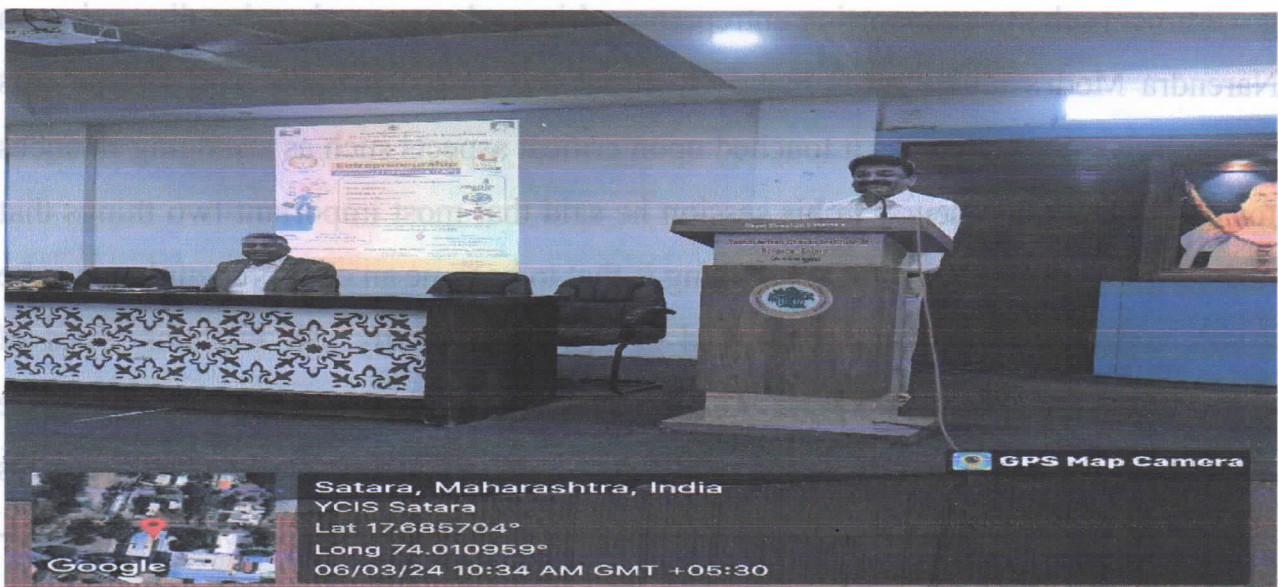


Session I

Mr. Rajesh Chanchlani sir in his session, delved into various facets of entrepreneurship, providing valuable insights on what it takes to be a successful entrepreneur. He covered diverse topics, including the types of entrepreneurs, government schemes supporting entrepreneurship, and a comprehensive discussion on Narendra Modi's initiatives – Stand Up India and Start Up India. The session was particularly enlightening as it touched upon critical aspects such as arranging finances for budding entrepreneurs. In his session he said that most important two things that make a good entrepreneur. The first thing is that to become an entrepreneur he must be a risk taker, confident and committed to his work. Firstly, Sir explains types of entrepreneurs. Then next he explains various types of government schemes like Annabhau sath scheme for supporting the entrepreneurship. After that he told Narendra Modi's initiatives of Stand-Up India and Start Up India. He told that in stand-up India it gives upto 10 lakh rupees of funding of only SC, ST caste people and also for womens in every category without any experience. This scheme is not applicable

for other than SC, ST people. But other communities other than this caste also gives a funding from stand India upto 10 lakh to 25 lakh. But there is a condition that he take partnership of one of the person in his family like his mother, father, sister, brother or wife also and start up his business. After that he also told that there are many opportunities to start their own business, startups.

After that sir, highlighting real-world examples, revealed that a remarkable 26% of businesses kick-started without any initial capital, while an inspiring 20% began with a mere investment of 1000 rupees. Additionally, he shed light on the rare but impactful 1% of businesses that commenced with an investment of 10 lakhs and beyond. This workshop not only provided valuable financial insights but also offered practical advice on initiating businesses without significant financial commitments. He also shared invaluable information about various funding schemes available for startups, emphasizing the importance of understanding the principles of business. He addressed the evolving landscape of future technologies in business, ensuring that participants were well-equipped to navigate the dynamic business environment. He spoke passionately about the vast opportunities in the business world. His guidance resonated strongly with the attendees, leaving them inspired and better informed about the exciting prospects in the entrepreneur.


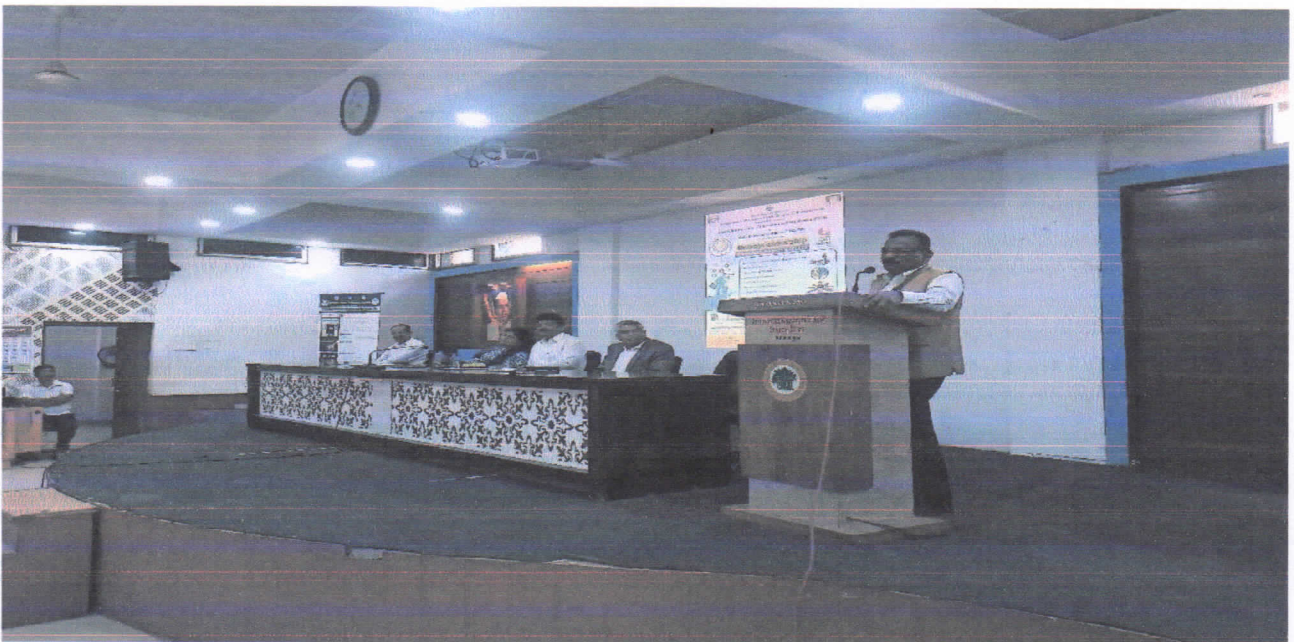
